She has supported operations in the European, African, Middle East and Pacific theaters and has deployed in support of numerous overseas operations. She was also a National Security Fellow at the John F. Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University in Cambridge, MA as part of the in-residence Senior Developmental Education (SDE) program. During her year at Harvard, Colonel Robinson studied issues pertaining to national security and authored a 100-page policy paper on increasing the security of the United States critical infrastructure in cyberspace.
