BRIGADIER GENERAL PAUL D. JOHNSON

Brig. Gen. Paul D. Johnson is the Commander of the 175th Wing, Maryland Air National Guard. The 175th Wing has over 1,400 personnel supporting an A-10 Group, a Cyber Operations Group and an Intelligence Squadron. In this role, he is responsible for the combat readiness of 21 A-10C aircraft and their associated aircrew and maintainers. The General oversees a budget in excess of \$46 million in addition to over \$37 million in base infrastructure and real property.

General Johnson was commissioned in 1988 as an Air Force Reserve Officer Training Course Distinguished Graduate of the University of Maryland. Following assignment as a T-37B Instructor and Evaluator Pilot, he was a Distinguished Graduate of F-15 training. He served as Flight Commander at Langley AFB, VA and as Instructor Pilot in the Massachusetts Air National Guard. General Johnson joined the Maryland Air



National Guard in 2000 and converted to the A-10. He is a command pilot with over 5,200 flying hours and has flown 881.4 combat hours during 248 combat sorties in the F-15 and A-10. Prior to his role as the 175th Vice Commander, General Johnson served as Instructor Pilot, Evaluator Pilot, Chief of Current Operations, Chief of Wing Safety, Director of Operations and Group Commander. General Johnson served on National Guard Bureau staff as Chief, Operations Plans and Execution Branch. Prior to his current assignment, General Johnson was the Vice Commander of the 175th Wing, Maryland Air National Guard.
