CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT PAUL D. MUGGLI

CMSgt Paul Daniel Muggli is the 175th Wing Command Chief, Martin State Airport, Baltimore Md. He serves as the key enlisted advocate and advisor to the Wing Commander on operational effectiveness and training of the Wing's enlisted Airmen. He is a key member of the command's leadership team and works with other enlisted leaders to include the State Command Chief, Group Superintendents and First Sergeants concerning enlisted matters. Chief Muggli advises the Wing Commander concerning enlisted promotions, recognition programs, awards and decorations. He participates in the Wing Force Management Plan concerning all enlisted members and is responsible for the professional development of 1,300 Airmen. As the wing's First Sergeant Functional Manager, Chief Muggli oversees the First Sergeant program, to include the selection process and the Wing First Sergeant Council.



CMSgt Muggli entered the Air Force in January 1998 and completed Basic Military Training. He then attended technical training and graduated as an Aircrew Life Support Apprentice in May 1998. Upon graduation, he served more than six years on active duty before transitioning to the Maryland Air National Guard, where he served as the 104th Fighter Squadron Aircrew Life Support Noncommissioned Officer In Charge. Since joining the Maryland Air National Guard, Chief Muggli has held multiple roles, to include training manager, deployment manager, aircrew flight equipment superintendent, and wing inspections superintendent. During his assignments as an aircrew life support/flight equipment technician, Chief Muggli participated in Operations Desert Fox, Southern Watch, Northern Watch, Noble Eagle, Iraqi Freedom, and Enduring Freedom. In 2009 he was instrumental in mobilizing the largest to date Maryland Air National Guard deployment as the 104th Fighter Squadron unit deployment manager. In 2012, he was selected as the Helmet Mounted Integrated Targeting System program manager for the ANG aircrew flight equipment career field during the initial fielding of the program. Prior to accepting his current position, Chief Muggli served as the Air National Guard's Aircrew Flight Equipment Career Field Functional Manager, Air National Guard Readiness Center (ANGRC), Joint Base Andrews, Md. In that position, he was responsible for organizing, training and equipping over 1,000 Airmen across 77 wings.
