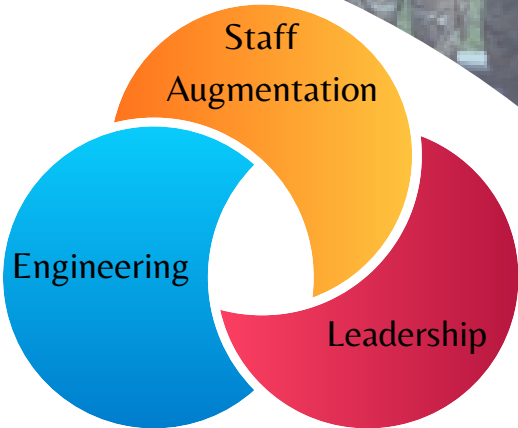

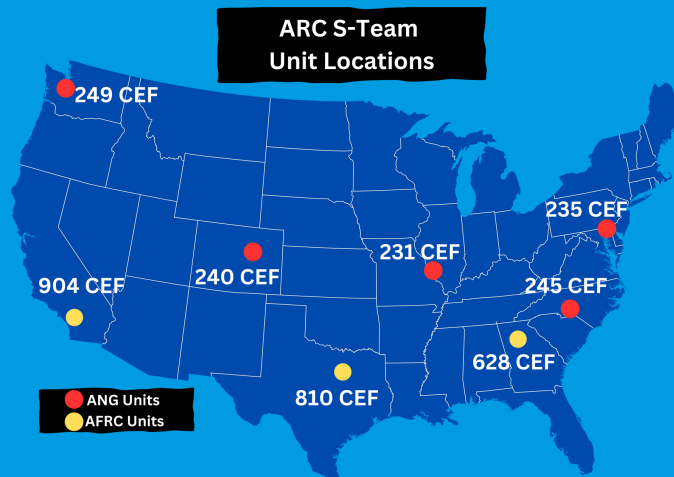


## 235th CEF

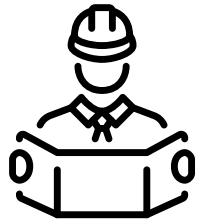
