Chief Master Sergeant Stanley F. Dulski Jr. currently serves as the 175th Wing Command Chief Maryland Air National Guard. He serves as the Senior Enlisted leader of the Wing, maintaining a liaison with the Wing Commander, Wing Staff, and State Command Chief. He is the principle advisor to the Wing Commander on matters of health, morale and welfare, and the awards and decorations program. He participates in the Wing Force Management Plan concerning all enlisted members and is responsible for the professional development of 1300 members. Chief Dulski also oversees the First Sergeant program, to include the selection process and the Wing First Sergeant Council.



Chief Dulski enlisted in the Air National Guard and reported to Lackland Air Force Base, Texas for Air Force Basic Military Training in June 1984. His career began as an Electrical Power Production Specialist and he has served in numerous leadership positions within the Civil Engineer career field. Prior to his current assignment Chief Dulski was the Facility Systems Superintendent for the Squadron, where he coordinated Electrical install and maintenance projects and oversaw the training and development of the Electrical and Electrical Power Production sections. Chief Dulski accepted his current position as the 175th Wing Command Chief in May of 2016
